

ORGANIC FARMING IN TURKEY

- In Turkey, organic agriculture started with the demand coming from enlarging European organic market in 1980s
- Turkey is one of the most suitable countries for organic farming due to the presence of a wide variety of agro-food products ranging from cold temperate to subtropical well adapted to different agroecosystems, rich biodiversity and traditions in agriculture.
- Area certified as organic is ca 2% of the total agricultural land



ORGANIC FARMING IN TURKEY

- Still the major market is the export market European countries like Germany, UK, Netherlands, France and USA
- Among exported goods, the processed products e.g. fruit juice, deep-frozen fruit and vegetables, tea, medicinal and aromatic plants
- Turkey ranks in the first place in hazelnuts, dried figs and dried apricots production in the world, forth in fresh vegetables, grape and tobacco production and seventh in wheat and cotton production
- In Turkey 20 CB is actively working













ORGANIC AGRICULTURE IN TURKEY- FARMERS






ORGANIC AGRICULTURE IN TURKEY- AREA

ORGANIC FARMING LEGISLATION

- First regulation on organic plant production issued in 1994
- Law on Organic Agriculture enforced in December 2004
- Bylaw on organic plant and animal production that is similar to the EU in its essence is issued in 2005 and later amended
- The final revision of the Turkish regulation on Organic that is in line with the newly adopted EU Regulation is issued on August 18, 2010 and came into force on November 18, 2010.
- Turkey applied to be on the third country list of the EU
